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When the weather warms up, it's time to set our sights on lighter, quaffable wines like rosé. It used to be very uncool to drink pink wine, but about a decade ago this began to change.

For the last few years, I've been waiting to see if the rosé bubble is in danger of bursting, but sales still keep on improving. In France, they now drink more rosé than white wine. The first of their new vintage rosés are beginning to arrive on the market. This week's selection of French rosés are compulsory drinking when the sun comes out.
