2015 PINOT NOIR, SEVEN SPRINGS, EOLA-AMITY HILLS Framed by crystalline yet lifted notes of rose hip and cherry blossom the wine states its place of origin with fine, iron-rich tannins and purity of fruit. We are quite proud of our freshman effort from such a fantastic vineyard.

THE VINEYARD, established by the legendary Al Macdonald in 1984, is an east-facing rocky volcanic site located in the heart of the Eola-Amity Hills AVA. The Pacific influence of the Van Duzer Corridor cools and regulates the 60 plus acres of vineyard, allowing the grapes an idyllic ripening environment. Dry-farmed and now completely transitioned to biodynamic farming practices, the vineyard thrives under the stewardship of its current farmers.

THE VINTAGE While rather warm by Oregon standards, this vineyard site is cooled by Pacific breezes. Our block was one of the last to ripen and retains tremendous freshness and bright acidity.
