Appellation	Napa Valley
Sites	Oakville, 37%; Rutherford, 34%; Mt. Veeder, 29%.
Soil	Napa Valley soils are primarily comprised of broken down or decomposed rock that has been carried downhill from the eastern Vaca range and the western Mayacamas range into the base of the valley, where they ultimately intermingle with the silt, clay and gravel deposits of the Napa River flood plain.

VINTAGE

Growing Season	2013 summed up to be a perfect vintage with clear sunny days and cool evenings, untroubled by untimely rain or heat spikes.

WINEMAKING

Varietal Composition	91% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Cabernet Franc
Fermentation	Native-yeast and full natural malolactic fermentations.
Aging	Aging the 2013 <i>sur lies</i> with monthly <i>bâtonnage</i> has coated the tannins and smoothly integrated the wood. We aged this vintage 23 months in new French oak barrels (Taransaud and Darnajou). Non-filtered.
