For more than 50 years, the Chappellet family has been crafting renowned wines made from fruit cultivated on the steep, rocky slopes of Napa Valley's Pritchard Hill. As one of the first wineries to pioneer high-elevation hillside planting, and one of the few remaining great family-owned Napa Valley wineries, Chappellet has influenced generations of vintners.

2019 CABERNET FRANC

The *Chappellet Cabernet Franc* is a traditional Bordeaux blend with Cabernet Franc at its base. The original vines were planted in 1989, making Cabernet Franc a relatively new addition to Pritchard Hill. This variety thrives on the hill's volcanic soils, where conditions are ideal for developing ripe, concentrated flavors.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2019 vintage delivered a long warm summer with perfect harvest conditions. Rich, dark and concentrated, this wine displays luxurious aromas of cassis, dark cherry, ripe plum, dark chocolate and sweet baking spices.
